#### **Partnership Game Day**









s property managers one of our key business goals is to provide good customer service to maintain superior resident relations. As you are aware, trying to make each of our residents happy can be a challenging job. We serve residents with a variety of personalities and dispositions. Like you and I, our residents sometime have bad days, personal issues, health concerns, and other stressors that may put them in a bad mood. Having professional interactions with residents on a consistent basis, even if they are not in a good mood, is vitally important. Treating residents fairly & courteously giving them the respect they deserve is the right thing to do and it's our policy. Fair Housing complaints are often prompted by an interaction during which a resident or applicant felt a staff member was disrespectful or short with them. Taking time to listen, understand, and help our residents can be the step that possibly prevents a costly fair housing complaint.

A few pointers to remember:

- Provide everyone with a warm welcome when they enter your office.
- Have a smile on your face, even when you're talking on the phone.
- STAY POSITIVE.
- Take time to listen to a resident's situation thoroughly without seeming frustrated or uninterested. People making a formal complaint are giving you an opportunity to address their concerns before they escalate their concerns to someone else. Take advantage of the opportunity.
- Everyone wants to be heard. Be a good listener.
- Don't talk over your residents. If a resident gets loud, begins using profanity, or becomes unruly, it is ok to ask them to leave and come back when they have calmed down so you can help them.
- Treat everyone as you would want to be treated, with respect, courtesy, and honesty.
- When someone brings a concern to your attention, do your best to resolve the issues as quickly as possible while keeping everyone involved of the progress you make along the way.
- If you make a promise to a resident, keep it, but don't promise things that are outside of your power or ability. Take notes and follow up after meetings to ensure you don't forget what you promised.

Partnership Property Management is committed to the letter and the spirit of the Fair Housing Act. As we continue to show this commitment remember not to take business matters personally when someone is having a cloudy day, but use each interaction as an opportunity to bring a rainbow to someone's cloudy day.
